

# 2011 *Wildcat* Shootout

## **RULES:**

### **High School Basketball Rules as Modified below:**

#### **5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Grade *Cascade***

1. **No zone defenses**
2. Basketball size shall be intermediate (28.5" in circumference).
3. No defense in the back court will be allowed **until last 3 minutes of each half** at which a team can press in the backcourt, but only **man to man**.
4. Double teams are **allowed only inside the 3-point arc**.

#### **5<sup>th</sup> /6<sup>th</sup> Grade *Eastside***

1. **No Zone Defense/Press**
2. Basketball size shall be intermediate (28.5" in circumference).
3. Teams **can press** in the backcourt, **but only man to man**.
4. Double teams are **allowed only inside the 3-point arc**.

#### **7<sup>th</sup> Grade *Cascade***

1. **No Zone Defense/Press**
2. Basketball size shall be standard (used in high school).
3. Back court pressing allowed (**man to man only**)
4. Double teams are **allowed only inside the 3-point arc**.

#### **7<sup>th</sup> / 8<sup>th</sup> Grade *Eastside* / 8<sup>th</sup> *Cascade* and All Elite Divisions**

1. Open High School Rules
  2. Basketball size shall be standard (used in high school).
  3. Full high school rules allowing for zones, presses, double teams, etc.
- Games shall consist of two 20-minute halves – running clock – except stop clock last two minutes of half as long as long as neither team leads by 20 points.
  - Half time shall be 3 minutes
  - Minimum pre-game warm-up of 5 minutes
  - **3 Full time outs per game**

- **Overtimes shall be 3 minutes**
  - b). Teams will get 1 time-out per overtime.
- **Technical Fouls **automatic two points and possession of ball****
- **Mercy Rule:** Backcourt press is not allowed by leading team after 20-point difference in the score has been reached. If the lead shrinks to 15 points or less, the leading team may again backcourt press but only until the 20 point difference has been reached.
- **Home Team: (coin toss) is responsible to keep official scorebook.**
- **Visiting Team: will provide a timekeeper.** Instructions on clock will be provided if necessary (Our timekeepers may be available at some games).
- **Seeding for Sundays Championship Brackets will be determined by the following criteria:**
  - a). Win/Loss Record
  - b). Head-to-head Play
  - c). Total Point Differential, with a maximum of 20 points per game
  - d). Coin Toss
